Using the Airless Spray

- Protective equipment including non-slip goggles, facemask, and ear defenders must be 1. worn.
- 2 Do not smoke or use naked flames while handling paints or chemicals
- Follow the instructions provided with the paint, or other liquid that is planned to be used. 3. 4. Wash drips of paint or chemical off the skin immediately. Do not allow to dry, do not just
- brush off.
- The spray gun should be held firmly when squeezing the trigger because the pressure can 5. make it kick back
- Do not spray over electrical equipment. This could cause a short circuit and fire. It could 6. also deliver a fatal shock
- The spray should not be aimed at people or animals. 7.
- When the spray equipment is not in use, it should be switched off, the trigger should be 8. depressed to release any pressure and make safe.
- 9. If someone approaches the spray must be stopped.
- 10. Care must be taken not to accidently pull the plug from the socket.
- If it suspected that the cable may be cut or damaged in any way, switch off and unplug at 11. the mains before the equipment is inspected.
- Switch off and remove the plug from the socket before the machine is left unattended. 12.
- 13. When the work is finished the equipment must be thoroughly cleaned before the contents harden or set.
- 14. Facemask and gloves must be worn when cleaning the equipment especially if using solvents.
- Paints or toxic liquids must not be poured into drains; follow the manufacturer's 15. instructions regarding cleaning and disposal - or contact the hire company.
- **16.** The equipment must be returned to the hire shop in a clean condition.
- 17. If the equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.

Airless Spray

The rules and procedures in force where people are at work may require the person responsible for this equipment to carry out a specific risk assessment.

It is important to read all of this leaflet **BEFORE using the Airless Spray**

- 1. Electricity can be hazardous and must always be used with great care.
- Paint is ejected from the nozzle of this equipment at high pressure. Care must be taken not to cause injury by spraying over anyone
- З. Paints and solvents used with this equipment may be highly flammable and toxic. Appropriate precautions must be taken.
- This airless spray is designed for high pressure spraying of paints and emulsions, such as resinbased paints, and intumescent finishes for fireproofing.
- Spraying paints and chemicals at high pressure can cause injury or damage if the equipment is not used in a careful and controlled way.
- If the operator has not used the equipment before, they should take time to familiarise 6. themselves with the equipment before starting work.
- The job should be planned in order to foresee any problems that may occur so that they can be safely dealt with.
- The following items of personal protective equipment must be worn as a minimum: Impact resistant goggles: EN166 - B or BS2092 grade 1; Facemask 0 a minimum of EN149 FFP3(sl) protection or, preferably a respirator; Overalls; Gloves; RCD if using a 230volt mains supply.
- This equipment must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or 9 alcohol
- This airless spray is designed for use by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either 10 temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.
